

Pattern

Crochet this mini tiger with sock yarn and he will be very tiny.

Amifan

Sock Yarn is also a bit fluffy, so it looks sweet.

The pattern contains details photo's off the stripes.



Used Materials

- Crochet hook 1,25 mm
- Fiberfill
- Sewing Needle
- Stich marker
- Safety eyes 6,0 mm color blue

Used colors



Abbreviations

Sl st = slip stitch

ch = chain

sc = single crochet

hdc = half double crochet

dc = double crochet

inc = increase, 2sc in same stich

dec = decrease, crochet 2sc together

* * = crochet stiches mentioned in between * * multiple times / repeat

[] = total off stiches in round or row.

Pattern – extra info

If you crochet this pattern with sock yarn, i twill be really tiny. If you decide tot crochet it with normal cotton and a bigger hook it wil be more like an amigurumi size.

Color change

This pattern contains color changes. I mention this at the start of a round or before the stich.

Example:

Rnd 1. (B) 4sc [4] means the whole round is crochet in color black.

Rnd 1. (W)2sc, (B) 2sc [4]) means that two stiches are crochet in white, and two ik black.

Colors used:

- B = black
- W = White



Nose

Crochet in white yarn

Rnd 1.6sc in magic circle [6]

Rnd 2.*inc, 1sc* crochet 3x [9]

Rnd 3.1sc in every stich [9]

Head

Crochet in white yarn

Rnd 1. 6sc in magic circle [6]

Rnd 2. *inc* crochet 6x [12]

Rnd 3. *inc, 1sc* crochet 6x [18]

Rnd 4. *1sc, inc, 1sc* crochet 6x [24]

Rnd 5. 1sc in every stich [24]

Rnd 6. *inc, 3sc* crochet 6x [30]

Rnd 7. *2sc, inc, 2sc* crochet 6x [30]

Rnd 8. 1sc in every stich [36]

Rnd 9. 1sc in every stich [36]

Rnd 10. 1sc in every stich [36]

Rnd 11. 1sc in every stich [36]

Rnd 12. 1sc in every stich [36]

Rnd 13. *2sc, dec, 2sc* crochet 6x [30]

Rnd 14. *3sc, dec* crochet 6x [24]

Rnd 15. 1sc in every stich [24]

Rnd 16. *1sc, dec, 1sc* crochet 6x [18]

Fill up the head with fiberfill. Place the safety eyes on rnd10. 6 Stiches between the eyes and check if the nose fits in

between.

Rnd 17. *dec, 1sc* crochet 6x [12]

Rnd 18. *dec* crochet 6x [6]

Close the gap.

Ears (2x)

Crochet with black and white yarn

Rnd 1. (B): 6sc in magic circle [6]

Rnd 2. (W): *inc* crochet 6x [12]

Rnd 3. (W): 1sc in every stich [12]

Rnd 4. (W): 1sc in every stich [12]

Fold together and leave a yarn for sewing.

Body

Crochet with white yarn

Rnd 1. 6sc in magic circle [6]

Rnd 2. *inc* crochet 6x [12]

Rnd 3. *inc, 1sc* crochet 6x [18]

Rnd 4. 1sc in every stich [18]

Rnd 5. 1sc in every stich [18]

Rnd 6. 1sc in every stich [18]

Rnd 7. *dec, 1sc* crochet 6x [12]



Rnd 8. 1sc in every stich [12]

Fill up the body and leave a yarn for sewing the body and head together.

Back paws (2x)

Crochet with white yarn

Rnd 1. 5sc in magic circle [6]

Rnd 2. 1sc in every stich [5]

Rnd 3. 1sc in every stich [5]

Fold together and do not fill up.

Arms (2x)

Crochet with white yarn

Rnd 1. 5sc in magic circle [6]

Rnd 2. 1sc in every stich [5]

Rnd 3. 1sc in every stich [5]

Do not fill up

Tail

Crochet with black and white yarn

Rnd 1. (B): 6sc in magic circle [6]

Rnd 2. (B) 1sc in every stich [6]

Rnd 3. (W): 1sc in every stich [6]

Rnd 4. (W) Repeat Rnd 3 until rnd 20 [6]

Assembly

Put all the parts together. So sew the head on the body. The paws at the front (flat) and the arms aside off the body.

Sew the nose between the eyes.

Embroider with pink yarn a litte nose (one line). And with black yarn a mouth. (see photo 1).

Stripes

- a. Around the eyes at the top around, till half way under black yarn.
- b. Side off the head thick black stripes (3 times) from ears till arms.
- c. Embroider with black a pattern on his head. One stripe in the middle. And than thin and thicker stripes on both sides off the middle stripe. Al tigers are different so do your own thing .
- d. Back off the body. Same as c.
- e. Tail also little black stripes..

Paws: 3 little black stripes to give it some nails. (photo 1 and 3)















Crochet tips!

All my amigurumi figures are crochet in spiral rounds. If not, I will mention it.

The colors in my patterns are an example. You always can choose your own. This also for the yarn. That is why I stopped telling the yarn I use, unless I want to have a special effect.

I crochet with 100% cotton yarn. Fluffy yarn is always acryl.
