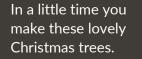

# Pattern Christmas Juletræ



Ad some eyes and they become so sweet (3).

I call these trees Juletræ, that is Danish for Christmas tree.



### **Used Materials**

- Crochet hook 2,0 mm
- Fiberfill
- Sewing Needle
- Marker
- Safety eyes 6 mm

### Used colors



## **Crochet Terms (US)**

ch = chain sc = stich

inc = increase

- dec = decrease
- slst = slip stich
- \* \* crochet .. x= repeat and crochet x times what is between \* \*
- [ ] = total off stiches in round
- FS = frontside loops
- BS = Backside loops



### Pattern Christmas Juletræ

A simple pattern for a more experienced crocheter. But if you can do the basics... it is a fun small project to start with.

### Tip!

The garland is also nice in colors gold or silver. And who is telling you the tree must be green? Try a red or pink tree and see how it looks.

### Tree (green tree)

Start with color green. Braun will be at the end. Keep safety eyes also ready.

Rnd 1. Crochet 6st in magic circle (= 6) Rnd 2. 6sc (=6) Rnd 3. 6sc (=6) Rnd 4. \*inc, 1sc \* crochet 3x (=9)Rnd 5. \*inc\* crochet 9x (=18) ' Rnd 6. 18sc(=18) Rnd 7. FS, \*dec, 1v\* crochet 6x (=12) Rnd 8. BS 12sc (=12) Rnd 9. \*1sc, inc, 1sc\* crochet 4x (=16) Rnd 10. \*inc, 1sc\* crochet 8x (=24) Rnd 11. 24sc (=24) Rnd 12. FS \*1sc, dec, 1sc\* crochet 6x (=18) Rnd 13. BS 18sc (=18) Rnd 14. \*1sc, inc \* crochet 9x (=27) Rnd 15. \*1sc, inc, 1sc\* crochet 9x (=36) Rnd 16. \*5sc, inc\* crochet 6x (=42) Rnd 17. 42sc (=42) Rnd 18. FS \*5sc, dec\* crochet 6x (=36) Rnd 19. \*2sc, dec, 2sc\* crochet 6x (=30) Rnd 20. \*3sc, dec\* crochet 6x (=24) Rnd 21. \*1sc, dec, 1sc\* crochet 6x (=18) Rnd 22. \*dec, 1sc \* crochet 6x (=12) Fill up with fiberfill. Place safety eyes on round 16, with 6 stiches in between.

Change to color braun.

Rnd 23. BS 12sc (=12) Rnd 24. 12sc (=12) Rnd 25. 12sc (=12) Rnd 26. FS \*dec\* crochet 6x. Fill up with fiberfill. And leave a yarn for sewing.

#### Ground on tree

Start with grey yarn on Rnd 24 on the tree on de BS loops. Crochet further.

Rnd 27. 12slst (=12) Rnd 28. BS \*1sc, 3sc in st, 1sc\* crochet 4x (=20) Rnd 29. \*2sc, 3sc in st, 2sc\* crochet 4x (=28) Rnd 30. 28sc (=28) Rnd 31. 28slst (=28)

End off. And close with the braun yarn the gap in the tree. Do not overfill the tree so it does not collapse. But firm enough.

### Garland

Start with white or colored yarn.

\*crochet 8 chain, from the 5<sup>e</sup> chain from the crochet hook, 1slst (you made a picot from 3ch) \* crochet this 8x, end off with chain 5.

Sew the garland on the tree, from the top how you like it. Do not cover the eyes.



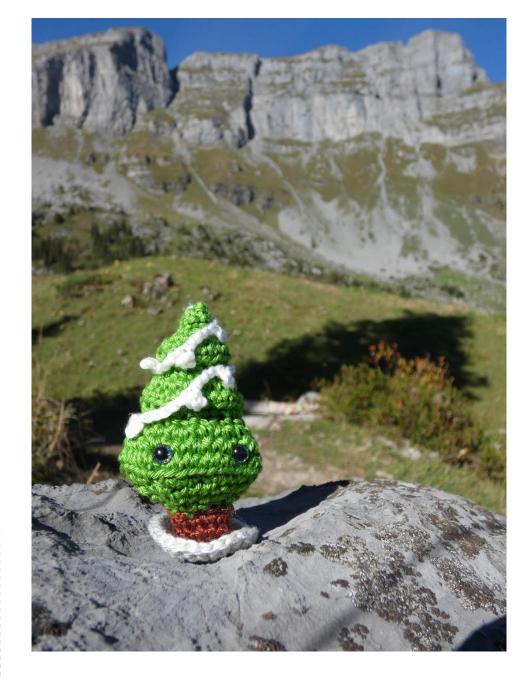


### Tree (with snow, without eyes)

This tree is a bit smaller and without eyes. Make the pattern with the following color changes:

Rnd 23. Rnd 1-2 white Rnd 3-4 green Rnd 5-7 white Rnd 8-9 green Rnd 10-12 white Rnd 13-14 green Rnd 15 white Rnd 16 white = 36sc Rnd 17 white = BS \*2sc, dec, 2sc\* crochet 6x (=30) Rnd 18-20 green = Rnd 20-22

Go further with pattern.







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## **CROCHET TIPS !**

The amigurumi figures are crochet in on going spiral. If crochet in rows I will mention it in the pattern.

The colors yarn I used are just a hint. You always can use other colors. That is why I stopped telling which brand yarn I use. Except when I want to have a special effect.

I always use 100% cotton yarn or acryl when it must be fluffy.





I am a Dutch designer off amigurumi and since 2012 active on social media. I crochet since 2003 and learned it myself by YouTube. Soon I fall in love with the Japanese amigurumi. In Dutch there were not many patterns, so I tried to design them myself.
